## 2018-2019 School Year - Continued

- Reconsider the offerings at MHS
- Latin-7 sections, average class size 16
- Italian-7 sections, average class size 16
- German-5 sections, average class size 17
- French - 13 sections, average class size 18
- Spanish - 42 sections, average class size 22
- Mandarin - 5 sections, average class size 18


## 2018-2019 School Year - Continued

- Running three different languages with low enrollment is budgetarily inefficient
- Consider reducing the number of sections in two of the three languages
- Consider adding a critical language (ex: Arabic or Hindi) with the money saved
- Develop curriculum for new language; recruit a teacher
