Elementary Schools	Date/Time	Activity
BRADFORD	5/23 at various times 5/23	Joke-a-thon for K Schoolwide wearing red. Various grades holding discussion around childhood poverty.
BULLOCK	5/23 11:10 am – 1:45 pm 5/20 – 5/31	Painting RED noses at recess Children wearing RED noses all day and RED clothing Donation collection boxes in classrooms
EDGEMONT	5/23 – all day K-3 GR4 GR5	Wearing RED Kindness promotion Poverty discussion Help fight poverty discussion
HILLSIDE	5/23 – all day	All staff and students will wear RED. Seeking \$1 donations to get a red nose and Hillside's trees will be decorated with red nose faces.
NISHUANE	5/23 – all day	All Red Spirit day and schoolwide Read-In (read aloud story on the topic). Students and staff encouraged to wear RED and donations collected in a RED jar in the office.
NORTHEAST	5/20 – 5/24	Buckets and Beyond students will make daily announcements that tie Red Nose Day into monthly theme of caring; they will distribute a flyer and request "Change to Help Change Kids Lives." These donations will be collected in homerooms daily & placed in the office in the large RED nose bucket
WATCHUNG	5/23 – all day	Morning announcement to end child poverty. Children donate to get a RED nose that they can wear all day.

BUZZ ALDRIN	5/23 all day at various times	Staff and students encouraged to wear red. Morning announcements made all week. Selling red noses for \$1 each. Will have a "Guess how many noses are in the jar" table and will provide a prize for the winner. Guesses will be 50 cents each.
GLENFIELD	5/17 5/23 all day	Art Festival. Participants guessed how many red noses were in a glass globe. Each guess cost \$1 and each participant received an info card on child poverty and a chance to win a gift card. Students making morning announcements related to Red nose day and ending child poverty. Wearing red and mini lessons in social studies classrooms.
RENAISSANCE	5/23 all day	Staff will be handing out red noses to any student who wears a red shirt. During each lunch period students will tell a joke for \$1. Hosting a poster contest to raise awareness for child poverty.
MHS	5/23 Lunch Time	Students will participate in a fundraising effort by dedicating a red nose on our RED Nose Day Wall. Students and staff will also wear red in support of this initiative.
