Gifted & Talented Education Information

Dear Parents/Caregivers:

We are embarking upon the district Gifted & Talented Identification Process for the 24-25SY. Identification measures were selected to cast a wide net to "find" all students who will benefit from services for gifted learners. We offer referrals through multiple pathways: teachers, parents/guardians, and assessment scores.

Teachers, parents, and guardians are invited to refer students for consideration for gifted services. In addition, district personnel will review achievement and aptitude scores (universal screening procedures) to include those students who may not have been referred by teachers, parents, or guardians in the identification process.

If you believe your child/student would benefit from gifted services, you are invited to refer them. The referral window will be open Monday, March 4th (9:00am) - Friday, March 15th (4:00pm). Please note there will be no teacher, parent, and guardian referrals accepted after 4:00pm on March 15th, no exceptions.

Nos estamos embarcando en el proceso de identificación de dotados y talentosos del distrito para el 24-25SY.

Se seleccionaron medidas de identificación para lanzar una amplia red para "encontrar" a todos los estudiantes que se beneficiarán de los servicios para estudiantes superdotados. Ofrecemos referencias a través de múltiples vías: maestros, padres/tutores y puntajes de evaluaciones.

La ventana de referencia estará abierta del lunes 4 de marzo (9:00 a. m.) al viernes 15 de marzo (4:00 p. m.). Tenga en cuenta que no se aceptarán referencias de maestros, padres ni tutores después de las 4:00 p. m. del 15 de marzo, sin excepciones.
