Nursing Note: Northeast's School Health Office is busy this time of year with coughs and colds!

- Be sure to keep your child at home for 24 hours after vomiting, diarrhea, or the resolution of a fever. If your child needs Tylenol or Motrin to bring the fever down, it has not yet resolved. Once the fever ends, your child should not be in school for another full day.
- Viruses aren't usually treated with antibiotics, but your child can remain contagious from several days before symptoms start until symptoms end.
- Remember to encourage your children to wash their hands after going outside, blowing their nose, using the bathroom, and before eating.
- Teaching a child to cover a cough with their elbow is the best! Coughing into hands can spread germs.
- Wearing a mask is not mandatory, but if your child is coughing, it is kind to encourage them to wear one to prevent others from becoming ill. Masks are always available in the health office.

I have been working with your children on proper hand washing. If they have visited the nurse, ask them if they practiced how to wash their hands! If you have any questions about your child returning to school after an illness, please call me at 973-509-4241.
