WHEREAS, N.J.S.A. 40A:11-11(5) et seq, N.J.S.A. 18A:18A et seq and N.J.A.C. 5:34-7.29(c) and per

Local Finance Notice No. LFN 2011-35 authorizes contracting units to establish a Cooperative Pricing System and to enter into Cooperative Pricing Agreements for its

administration; and

WHEREAS, the New Jersey School Boards Association has offered voluntary participation in a

Cooperative Pricing System through multiple lead agencies, for the purchase of goods

and services;

WHEREAS, on October 19, 2020 the governing body of the Montclair Public School District, County

of Essex, State of New Jersey duly considered participation in a Cooperative Pricing System for the provision and performance of goods and services with New Jersey School Boards Association's Technology for Education and Career (NJSBA TEC) program, which provides cost-saving solutions for delivering the most current school technology and

digital learning opportunities,
