FOOD SERVICE MANAGEMENT CONTRACT AND GUARANTEE LANGUAGE FOR SCHOOL YEAR 2021-2022

BE IT RESOLVED that upon the recommendation of the Superintendent, the Montclair Board of Education (SFA) approves the renewal of the Food Service Management contract with The Pomptonian, Inc. (FSMC) for the food service operation for 2021-2022.

The FSMC shall receive, in addition to the costs of operation, an administrative/management fee of \$0.1772 per reimbursable meal and meal equivalent to compensate the FSMC for administrative and management costs. This fee shall be billed monthly as a cost of operation. The SFA guarantees the payment of such costs and fee to the FSMC.

Total meals are calculated by adding reimbursable meal pattern meals served and meal equivalents. The number of reimbursable meals served to the children shall be determined by actual count. Cash receipts, other than from sales of reimbursable program meals served to the children, shall be divided by \$1.00 to arrive at an equivalent meal count.

The per meal administrative/management fee of \$0.1772 will be multiplied by total meals.

As a result of the uncertainties during the public health emergency, there is no guaranteed operating result for the 2021-2022 school year.
